

Mallory Fobes a rising fifth year Senior at UNC-W wasn't sure she would be have the chance to contend for the 74th playing of the North Carolina Women's State Championship. Entering Thursdays final round, Fobes trailed Campbell Women's Golf Coach Ashley Sease by six strokes. Seemingly unnerved, Fobes opened the round with 2 straight pars while Sease displayed a few nerves opening her final round with two bogies and then a double at the par five 3rd. With the margin now at three Fobes played the remaining six holes one under par to turn at 37 and cutting the 36 hole lead by Sease to just one with nine to play. Ashley Sease picked up two quickly at the par four 10th with a birdie and brought the lead back to three with eight to go. The two battled as the pins were tucked and positioned in the narrow necks of both front and back locations on greens that were rolling around 12 on the stimp meter. Mallory steadied the ship parring the next five while Sease bogied the par three eleventh and the par four fifteenth bringing her lead to just a single stroke with only three holes remaining. Mallory Fobes tied the lead with a birdie at the par five sixteenth hole and the two were all square with just two to play. Sease found trouble at the seventeenth and carded a double bogie six and for the first time in three days Fobes took a two stroke lead heading into the final hole. Mallory Fobes closed the deal with a birdie recording her second North Carolina Championship.
